## HG KIDS SUNDAY MORNINGS

### SUNDAY SCHOOL

#### **Sunday School Teacher**

Invest in a group of 10-15 children as you teach them God's Word from curriculum provided.

#### **Preschool Worship Team (WEEKLY)**

Lead 3's-K in fun and energetic worship music, called Kid's Place, during the 9:30 AM worship hour.

## AWANA

### Positions available

Preschool (2's -4's) and Elementary (K-5th grade)

Commitment: September-May

### Elementary Director (WEEKLY)

Facilitate a team of 6-9 Awana Captains and 20+ Coaches in prayer, communication, and support. Expectations include recruitment and weekly attendance.

### Captain (WEEKLY)

Invest in a group of 10-15 children by participating with them in Large Group, Game Time, and leading them in memory games during Handbook Time.

### Game Time Line Leader

Have a blast helping the Game Time Director facilitate games in the gym.

### Infant - 1's Volunteer

Invest in the lives of young preschoolers by providing them with a loving, caring environment.

### Coach (WEEKLY)

Invest in a group of 4-6 children through one-on-one discipleship by listening to them recite Scripture from memory and helping them on their memory work.

### Secretary (WEEKLY)

Provide administrative support to Directors, Captains, and Coaches by compiling records and preparing Awana awards.

### Greeter

Welcome families and assist guests with check-in, finding their classrooms, and basic information about Hickory Grove and the HG Kids Ministry.

## HG KIDS SEASONAL

### VBS Volunteer

Support the year's largest outreach event by leading a family group, helping with crafts, leading in recreation, participating on the worship team, or helping with registration.

### Father & Child Campout Volunteer

Help set up camp, assist with registration, tend to the fire, monitor the fishing pond, or prepare meals.

### Kid's Camp Volunteer

Invest in a small group of 3rd-5th graders at camp by providing supervision and leading in small group Bible studies.

**In order to serve, you must be an active member with an approved background check and have a desire to invest spiritually in the next generation.**

## **Sunday School Leader**

Teach students the truth of God's Word while facilitating small group discussions and life application based on the weekly curriculum.

- Weekly commitment on Sunday mornings at 9:30 AM.

## **Student Worship Volunteers (WEDNESDAYS)**

Invest in students on a personal and spiritual level through greeting, intentional conversations, corporate worship, relationship building, and intentional follow-up.

## **Disciple Now (MARCH)**

A weekend conference with positions for host homes, family group leaders, and conference volunteers.

## **Camp Paradise (JULY)**

Positions include family group leaders, land recreation, water recreation, crafts, hospitality, medical, prayer, logistics, and production.

## **Operation Charlotte (AUGUST)**

A Live Sent initiative that takes the students out in the community to serve and share the Gospel. Positions include group leaders, hospitality, registration, and site coordination.

## **ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL**

### **Teacher**

- Must be a member of Hickory Grove for a minimum of one year and seek to comply with responsibilities as designated in the Sunday School Leadership Handbook.
- Must be approved to teach by the area Discipleship Pastor.

## **ADULT MISCELLANEOUS**

Medical Doctors, Nurses, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, and First Responders are needed to assist with medical emergencies should they arise on Sunday mornings, Sunday evenings, and Wednesday evenings.

Assist with set-up, working and clean-up at church-sponsored special events through-out the year.

### Guest and Member Services

Provide an exceptional experience for all our guests and members by answering questions, collecting guest information, and seeking to meet general and specific needs.

### HG Kids Check-in

Connect guests to the children's ministry and instill confidence that all children are safe, secure, and will be taught biblical truth while under our care. Requires training on electronic check-in and ability to work with computers.

### Parking Lot Attendants

Engage each guest and church member with enthusiasm which leads to an expectation as one enters our campus.

### Shuttle Bus Driver

Offer shuttle services to our guests and members from the parking lots to the Gathering Place during each Sunday morning service.

### Door Greeters

Welcome guests and church members with a smile. Provide direction and assistance with an attitude that helps set the stage for the work of the Holy Spirit.

### Ushers

Greet guests and church members as they enter the Worship Center. Distribute materials and be available to assist when needed.

**In order to serve, you must be an active church member. Commitment is quarterly and training is available.**

## **CG/IMAG Operator**

Control what is seen on front screens. Actively switch between computer and camera using an iMac and video switcher.

## **Lighting Technician**

Control all of the lighting in the Worship Center. This is automated with a computer program on a PC.

## **Camera Shader**

Assist the Video Director by controlling camera shading and recorders.

## **Camera Operator**

Operate camera equipment for worship services. This is cued by the Video Director during recording. Requires interpretation of what the Director wants and the ability to act quickly and effectively to achieve it.

## **Choir Mag**

Control what is seen on the back screen. Serve as a teleprompter for the choir and praise team, using an iMac.
