In order to serve with HG Kids you must be an active member of Hickory Grove and have an approved background check.

Sundays at 8:45 AM & 10:15 AM (unless otherwise specified) • Minimum 1 year commitment.

Positions available: Preschool (Infants - Kindergarten) and Elementary (1st - 5th Grades)

HG KIDS SUNDAY MORNINGS

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Sunday School Teacher (WEEKLY)

Invest in an age-graded class of 10-15 children by teaching The Gospel Project curriculum during the 8:45 AM Sunday School hour.

Worship Care Volunteer

Invest in the lives of Infants-Kindergarteners by providing a loving, caring environment during the 10:15 AM Worship Service.

Preschool Worship Team Leader (WEEKLY)

Help lead 3-5 Year Olds in fun and energetic praise music during the 10:15 AM Worship Care hour.

HG KIDS SUNDAY EVENINGS

Elementary Choir Team Leader

Assist in facilitating rehearsals, such as leading a dance team, helping soloists, keeping records, leading activities, etc. No music background necessary.

Worship Care Volunteer

Invest in the lives of Infants-2 Year Olds by providing a loving, caring environment.

Preschool Choir Team Leader

Assist in facilitating rehearsals and providing care for 3-4 year olds.

HG KIDS WEDNESDAY EVENINGS

AWANA

Positions available

Preschool (3's & 4's) and Elementary (K-5th grade).

Minimum 1 year commitment. August–May.

Captain (WEEKLY)

Invest in a group of 10-15 children by participating with them in Large Group, Game Time, and leading them in memory games during Handbook Time.

Game Time Line Leader

Have a blast helping the Game Time Director facilitate games in the gym.

Worship Care Volunteer

Invest in the lives of young preschoolers by providing them with a loving, caring environment while their parents are volunteering or being ministered to and equipped for ministry.

Coach (WEEKLY)

Invest in a smaller group of 4-6 children through one-on-one discipleship by listening to them recite Scripture from memory and helping them with their memory work.

Secretary (WEEKLY)

Provide administrative support to AWANA Directors, Captains, and Coaches by compiling records and preparing AWANA awards.

HG KIDS SEASONAL

VBS Volunteer

Support the year's largest outreach event by leading a family group, helping with crafts, leading in recreation, participating on the worship team, or helping with registration.

Father/Child Campout Volunteer

Help set up camp, tend to the fire, transport families on hayrides, or prepare meals.

CentriKid Camp Leader

Invest in a small group of 3rd-5th graders at camp by providing supervision and leading in small group Bible Studies.

In order to serve, you must be an active member with an approved background check and have a desire to invest spiritually in the next generation.

Sunday School Leader

Teach students the truth of God's Word while facilitating small group discussions and life application based on the weekly curriculum.

- Weekly commitment on Sunday mornings at 8:45 AM.

Students Equip Teacher

Teach students the truth of God's Word by leading through a selected

book in a small group setting.

- Weekly commitment on Sunday evenings at 5 PM.

Student Worship Volunteers

Invest in students on a personal and spiritual level through greeting, intentional conversations, corporate worship, relationship building, and intentional follow-up.

- Weekly commitment on Wednesday evenings at 6:15 PM.

ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

Teacher

Teach adults the truths of God's Word while fostering community and leading members to fulfill the mission of the church.

- Must be a member of Hickory Grove for a minimum of one year and seek to comply with responsibilities as designated in the Sunday School Leadership Handbook.
- Must be approved to teach by the Adult Discipleship Pastor.

Sunday School Servant Leader

Serve your Sunday School class through one of the various servant leader positions as designated in the Sunday School Leadership Handbook.

- Must be an active member of the Sunday School class (attendance >50%) and a faithful participant in corporate worship.
- Must be a member of the church.
- Must be approved by the Teacher of the Sunday School class.

ADULT MISCELLANEOUS

Special Event Volunteer

Assist with set-up, working and clean-up at church-sponsored special events throughout the year.

- Servers - Assist Food Services by serving food/beverages at special events throughout the year.
- Greeters - Welcome guests and members at special events. Provide general church information as needed. Opportunities to serve include day and evening hours.

Medical Response Team Volunteer

Medical Doctors, Nurses, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners and First Responders are needed to assist with medical emergencies should they arise on Sunday mornings.

Abide Childcare Volunteer

Minister to young mothers by caring for their children while they are being encouraged and equipped through Abide.

In order to serve, you must be a church member and 13 years or older.

Guest Parking Attendant

Set the standard for guests by serving as the initial face and voice of Hickory Grove. Your first words will provide a joyful welcome, conveying the hope in Christ that Hickory Grove seeks to celebrate.

Guest and Member Assistant

Provide an exceptional experience for all our guests and members by answering questions, collecting guest information and seeking to meet general and specific needs.

Shuttle Driver

Provide shuttle services from the parking lots to the lobby on Sunday mornings.

Kiosk Assistant

Connect guests to the children's ministry and instill confidence that all children are safe, secure and will be taught biblical truth while under our care as well as assist guests and members with the check-in process as needed. *(Requires training on electronic check-in and ability to work with computers.)*

- Monthly commitment on Sunday mornings at 8:15 AM.
- Additional opportunities to serve at special events throughout the year.

For Volunteer Coaching, the individual must:

- **Be an active member of Hickory Grove Baptist Church.**
- **Be willing to participate in any volunteer training.**
- **Have an approved background check.**

Volunteer Coaching

For people who understand the value of using sports to glorify Christ and teach life lessons. Individuals must be willing to invest in others (and their families) both athletically as well as spiritually.

- **Coaches needed:**

Youth basketball/cheerleading, youth baseball/softball, youth soccer, adult softball and adult flag football.

- **Time commitment:**

3hrs/week for 10-12 weeks.

In order to serve, you must be an active church member who is 18 years old or older and have an approved background check.

Circulation Desk Attendant

Assist patrons with check-in/check-out of items.

- Weekly, bi-weekly or monthly commitment on Sunday mornings, Sunday evenings, or Wednesday evenings.

Processing Volunteer

Prepare new items for circulation.

- Weekly, bi-weekly or monthly commitment during weekday office hours.

TECHNICAL SERVICES

Training is available. All volunteers must be active church members.

Audio Engineer

Control all audio inside the Worship Center, send audio to the video control room, mix all of the music, control all other audio sources. The Audio Engineer is in contact with the worship leader during services in order to make rapid audio adjustments as needed.

CG/IMAG Operator

Control what is seen on all screens. Actively switch between their computer and the signal from the Video Director using an iMac and video switcher.

Lighting Technician

Control all of the lighting in the Worship Center. This is automated with a computer program on a PC.

Producer

Maintain clear lines of communication between Pastor's transport from Main Campus to North Campus before service starts. Record a timetable of all service elements during the Sunday morning service.

Stage Manager

Assist the Pastor with prompt building/stage access. Communicate with the crew. Responsible for pulpit placement and stage curtain usage.

Video Assistant

Assist the Video Director by controlling camera shading and operating the live streaming computer and recorders.

Video Director

Switch between all cameras and graphics, instruct the camera crew, and actively make decisions to creatively share God's message through video.

Camera Operator

Operate camera equipment for worship services. This is practiced at rehearsal and is cued by the Video Director during recording. Requires interpretation of what the director wants and the ability to act quickly and effectively to achieve it.

Choir

Lead worship in the 10:15 AM service each Sunday. Rehearse with the choir

on a weekly basis to prepare for Sunday services and bi-annual Night of Worship events.

HG Food Pantry

Assist families experiencing financial crisis with nonperishable food items.

Open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10 AM -12 PM at the **LA**

Campus. The pantry is supplied through donations and volunteers help to sort and distribute the food.

Clothes Closet

Assists those in the community in need of clothing on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 AM-1 PM at **Main Campus**. Donations are accepted during these hours as well. Volunteers needed in sorting and organizing donations of clothing and assist visitors as needed.

Car Care

An outreach ministry in the community designed to provide oil changes on vehicles for single women and widows.

By appointment only.

This ministry opportunity is located at **Main Campus**.

ESL

Open to those in our community seeking to learn English as a second language. These classes meet weekly on Wednesday at **Main Campus** in Room 1109.

Prayer Shawl Ministry

Crochets and knits prayer shawls and lap blankets to share with critically ill church members, shut-ins, residents of area nursing homes, pregnancy crisis centers and children facing cancer and other life-threatening diseases.

Tuesday Group: Meets the fourth Tuesday of the month at 6:30 PM in the *Media Center* at **Main Campus**.

Thursday Group: Meets the second Thursday of the month at 9:30 AM in *Room 3312* at **Main Campus**.

Women of Mission

Gathers monthly to pray for our missionaries and complete various monthly service projects. Meet the first Tuesday of the month at 9 AM in Room 1113/1114 at **Main Campus**.

Alexander's Kids Network

A facility for troubled youth. We have two groups that conduct Bible studies, build friendships with crafts, pray with children and most importantly share the love of Jesus.

C.R.U.I.S.E.

Disaster Relief

The NC Baptist Men's Disaster Relief Ministry relieves human suffering caused by disasters by providing among other things: hot meals, debris removal, child care and family assistance.

Dove's Nest

Part of Charlotte Rescue Mission that shares the Christ to women caught in cycles of hopelessness and chemical addictions. Our group of volunteers visit Dove's Nest each month.

Hearts & Hammers

Volunteers needed with skills in general household repairs such as, but not limited to, yard work, carpentry, tree work, and plumbing.

- Must be 18 years old or accompanied by their guardian.

Lois' Lodge

A non-profit organization whose mission is to help women and families experiencing an unexpected pregnancy. Residential services are provided through a family-style home. Volunteers needed to encourage these women on a routine basis.

Wrapped in Love

Sharing Christ's love through creating quilts. Quilts go to places of ministry such as: Dove's Nest, Alexander Youth Network, Concord Pregnancy Centers, and many international mission trips. Volunteers needed on Thursdays at **North Campus** from 9 AM-12 PM to tack quilts together for missions.
